- Plan to arrive for your scheduled procedure as you have been directed.
- **DO NOT** eat or drink anything, including water, after midnight (12 a.m.) on the day of the procedure, unless otherwise directed by your surgeon.
- If you take blood pressure or heart medication, take these with a small sip of water on the day of the procedure.
- Make arrangements for a responsible adult driver to remain with you at the Surgery Center and to take you home.
- Parents of minors must remain in the waiting room during their child's surgery.

Check in at the registration desk located on the first floor. Please be sure to bring your insurance card, a photo ID and any requested forms.
